### Eagle Courts of Honor

On Sunday, August 15, St. Paul's United Methodist Church hosted an Eagle Court of Honor to recognize three Troop 31 Scouts who completed their Eagle Boards of Review a year ago.

Benjamin Dworsky, Tynan Butler, and Jaden Rigg were joined in the celebration by family, friends, and Troop 31 leaders, along with other family members viewing a live stream of the ceremony graciously provided by St. Paul's.

During his Scoutmaster Minute remarks, Mr. Messner commented that the three new Eagles were among the first in the Troop to have their Eagle project work

impacted by the pandemic and that they secured BSA-approved extensions to complete their projects.

Benjamin Dworsky is the 207th Eagle in Troop 31 history. He led the construction of bullpens for the State College Teener League fields for his Eagle project. He is a sophomore in the Penn State College of Agricultural Sciences majoring in Community, Environment, and Development.

Tynan Butler's Eagle project is a chimney swift nesting tower and informational kiosk, which stands next to the Klingsberg Aviary at the Shaver's Creek Environmental Center. He is the 208th Eagle in Troop 31 history and is a sophomore majoring in Voice Performance in the School of Music at Ithaca College.

Jaden Rigg is the 210th Eagle Scout in Troop 31 history and his Eagle project involved restoration of concrete planters and pillars in the Boalsburg Diamond. He is a sophomore at Rose Hulman Institute of Technology in Terre Haute, Indiana and recently completed a software programming internship in Indianapolis this summer.

- 1) Obtain a list of all active Troop 31 volunteers listed on our charter from the Committee Chair.
- 2) Maintain spreadsheet for Troop 31 B and Troop 31 G in accordance with PA State Volunteer guidelines that contains:
  - a. Volunteer Name
  - b. Member ID#
  - c. Email address
  - d. Position
  - e. Clearance expiration dates of [each is valid for 5 years]
    - i. PA State Police Criminal Background Check
    - ii. PA Child Abuse Clearance
    - iii. FBI Background Check OR Affidavit of 10-year Consecutive PA Residency
  - f. Youth Protection Training expiration date [valid for 2 years]
- 3) Record the **expiration dates** of clearances on the Troop 31 tracker spreadsheet.
- 4) Perform quarterly reviews of volunteer clearances and contact volunteers with expired clearances to alert them to renew.
- 5) Maintain communication with Angela Kaler at Juniata Valley Council on the status of our volunteer clearances.
- 6) Provide volunteer clearance status updates to Committee Chair and Scout leadership as requested for events.
- 7) Maintain "control sheet" with instructions and clearance documentation links for reference by new members.
- 8) Work with troop webmaster to upload the control sheet for reference to the troop website.
